Do you love to show at Cobleskill ? Cobleskill Fair again is offering FANTASTIC awards for exhibitors who support shows at the fairgrounds. There is **no cost**, but you do need to fill out a nomination form. See the Cobleskill Sunshine Open Show Series form! (available in show office)

New for 2017

Recreational Rider Division:

Open to any rider, however horse/pony **CANNOT** be nominated in the NYSSHA “Show” awards program. Equines nominated for NYSSHA’s Trail Riding program **are** allowed. Entries may enter other classes at the show if eligible. Classes offered for walk/trot and walk, trot, canter riders, in both equitation and pleasure. Riders may not cross enter between W/T and W/T/C.

Pre-Entry \$3/class with six ribbons and special award for class winners.

- ◆ Recreational Rider Equitation - judged on riders equitation (seat, hands, ability to control mount, etc.)
- ◆ Recreational Rider Pleasure - judged on manners & ability of horse to give a pleasureable ride.
- ◆ Recreational Rider Easter Egg & Spoon class will be run as a W/T class but is open to both W/T and W/T/C riders combined.

Second Chance Equine Division:

Open to horses, ponies and mules who have been adopted from rescue organizations, purchased from kill buyers to prevent from going to slaughter, former race horses starting a 2nd career or similar situations. Entries must be able to show proof they are qualified to the satisfaction of show management at the time of entry. Examples: copy of adoption paperwork, reclassification of registration papers (Ex. Non racing registration papers for Standardbreds), bill of sale from Moore’s Equine Rescue (kill buyer), etc. Purpose of this class is to reward exhibitors for taking the time to give equines a second chance to thrive and to shed light on the need of formerly unwanted equines.

Pre-Entry Fee \$3/class, with six ribbons and a special award for class winners.

◆ Second Chance Model Equine

Entries to enter the ring at a walk, line up head to tail and to be judge standing for breed type, quality and condition for their age. May be shown in halter or bridle; exhibitors to be neatly attired. Open to entries which meet the requirements of the Second Chance Equine Division.

◆ Second Chance Pleasure Under Saddle

Open to entries which meet the requirements of the Second Chance Equine Division. To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk and trot/jog/alternate gait. To be judged on the ability to give a nice pleasure ride, with manners being paramount. Additional testing at judges discretion. Entries may be shown without penalty in any type saddle and bridle; bridle does not have to be the same style as saddle, but exhibitors attire must match seat shown. Although it is not preferred, exhibitors may use two hands on a shank bit without being disqualified in this class only. Example: a former Standardbred race horse may be shown in a snaffle English bridle with two hands and the rider uses a western saddle and is attired in western riding attire. Protective boots, bandages, etc. are optional. Entries may cross enter into w/t/c classes without penalty if qualified at this show.

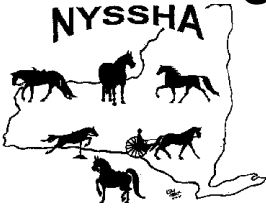

The undersigned also affirms that s/he is solely responsible for choosing and maintaining the horse and equipment that the undersigned uses and that the undersigned waives any claim for damages against NYSSHA and CCHA based on any injury due to the behavior of any animal that participated in a horse show or other equine event sponsored by NYSSHA and CCHA due to an equipment failure or defect. The undersigned further acknowledges that NYSSHA and CCHA is not responsible for the conduct of other participants in such horse show and their animals and hereby waives any claim for damages against NYSSHA and CCHA based on injury due to the conduct of another participant in such event or other participants' animals. **Per NYS Law No. VAT1235, all riders 17 years of age and under must wear a helmet meeting or exceeding ASTM F1163 (SEI certified) Equestrian Standards. The parent/guardian signing below is personally responsible for seeing that the exhibitor in their care, custody and control obeys this law. By signing below all parties agree to follow the rules and regulation of this event and that of the affiliated organization (NYSSHA) and to pay the proper fees in full with sufficient funds.**

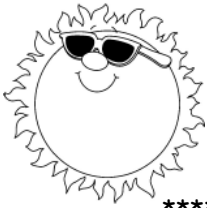
- ⌘ The show starts at 9am --we are offering over 100 classes each day!**please be ready for your class**
- ⌘ Pre-Entry deadline postmarked: May 28 for 6/3-4; August 12 for 8/19-20 Post Entries accepted on show day
- ⌘ keep tack change requests to a minimum and do all tack changes at ringside
- ⌘ we will bring the next class in on the rail while the previous class is lined up, except as noted in the nyssha rule book. **(we put two asterisks ** at the end of most class names** were we cannot bring in the next class per the rules, obviously in hand, driving & saddle seat events it is not permitted either)
- ⌘ New....Check out the new Recreational Rider division and Second Chance Equine divisions !!!!

RULES & REGULATIONS - CLASSIC COUNTRY HORSE ASSOCIATION OPEN HORSE SHOW

1. **All classes are open to everyone meeting the criteria listed for the class - you need not be an affiliated club member to participate!** NYSSHA rules will be observed in all NYSSHA pointed classes and the Academy classes. Rulebooks are available online at www.nyssha.org or at the entry booth for inspection. For more information call show manager Linda Voehringer 518-577-3387/cell or email teamassmann@live.com or show secretary Celeste O'Neill 518-466-2445. The judges decision is final and he/she has the right to dismiss any entry displaying unruliness or unsoundness. All inquiries to the judge must be made thru the show office. Exhibitors or agents making inquiries directly to the judge will be disqualified and no refunds issued.
2. **Awards & Fees:** Payback vouchers must be redeemed by the end of the show - no exceptions! Leadline classes receive award & ribbons for all. Recreational Rider & Second Chance Divisions: Pre-entry \$3/class, Post Entry at \$2 more per class; award & 6 ribbons. All other classes (except Leadline, Recreational Rider & Second Chance Divisions): with 10 or more in a class payback \$20 for 1st place; with 6-9 entries in a class payback \$10 for 1st place; for classes with less than 6 entries ribbons only. **Show Champions & Reserve Champions each day are also awarded!** Unless noted, Pre-entry fee is \$8/class, Post Entry fees at \$2 more per class are welcomed at least 3 classes in advance. Classes must be paid for as entered or a signed blank check left at the entry booth. Office Fee of \$6 per each horse/rider combination and grounds fee of \$10/day for non-stabled showing equines. Please be conservative with water usage, as this keeps grounds rental reasonable and these savings are passed onto the exhibitors. **Pre-Entries received without a "signed" check payable to Classic Country Horse Association, will not be considered for pre-entry fees.**
3. **Health Paperwork:** All entries must have a legible, current New York State (2016 or '17) coggins and (8/20/16 or later) rabies certificate available for inspection before back numbers are issued. **Coggins & Rabies cert. MUST be legible - if we can't read it, you will not be allowed to show - no exceptions.** If you would like, include a legible copy with your entry.
4. Each horse-rider combination must use a separate entry form. Each entry form must have the release statement signed by the exhibitor or a parent or legal guardian if the exhibitor is under 18 years of age. Failure to wear the correct number in a class or to sign the release statement will result in disqualification and forfeiture of entry fees for that class, forfeiting all prize money, awards, day end and NYSSHA points.
5. The show committee reserves the right to change, move, combine, add or cancel classes as warranted, decline or refuse an entry at this show without being held liable; eliminate from further competition any exhibitor or equine should the best interest of the show be served. Corrections to the prize list will be posted in the secretary's stand.
6. **Returned Checks:** A \$50 charge for non-negotiable checks if payment is made within 7 days of notification, \$75 thereafter. This is in addition to any bank fees, collection fees and the value of the check. Participation in future events will be barred until outstanding fees are paid. Exhibitors with non-negotiable checks will have checks posted at the show as well as in future prize lists. According to the NYS General Obligations Law, Section 11-104: if your check bounces you could be liable for the face value of the check, plus two times the amount of the check, up to \$400 for a check dishonored due to insufficient funds, and up to \$750 for checks drawn on a non-existing account. Bad check writers may also face criminal penalties.
7. **Refunds:** Pre-entry stall (or pre-entry grounds fees) and class fees will be refunded, only if a request in writing and an authentic veterinary certificate are received by show manager no later than 6 p.m. on 6/4 or 8/20 for the show. All other fees are non-refundable. All entered classes will be charged to the exhibitor regardless of scratches. Any changes to classes, exhibitor or equine will be treated as a new entry.
8. Age: **Exhibitors/Equine age** is as of January 1, 2017. All riders 17 years of age and under or competing in 17 yrs & under classes must wear a helmet meeting or exceeding ASTM F1163 (Safety Equipment Institute Certified) Equestrian Standard per NY State Law No. VAT1265.
9. **Trail classes** - may be held in the main ring or on an outside course both days. If entering multiple trail classes, you must designate the class you want to count for Year End awards with show secretary at time of entry, not after the class.
10. **◆ symbol denotes classes that are not pointed with NYSSHA.**
Hackney classes: Hackney Horse/Ponies must be registered; their classes will be judged according to USEF class specifications.
Open Roadster Pony: Open to any breed of registered pony (no minis); shown to a 2 wheel bike w/stable colors at a jog/trot, road gait & speed per USEF specs.
Owner to Ride Pleasure is judged same as Jack Benny Pleasure, except rider must be the owner.
Second Chance Equine Division -see specs elsewhere in prize list
Recreational Rider division -see specs elsewhere in prize list
11. **Camper/Stalls** - exhibitors must post the index card on your stall/camper that the club provides. Stalls available Friday after 6:00PM at \$30/stall on a FIRST COME FIRST SERVE BASIS; Campers \$60/weekend. You must post the index card the Club provides on your stall door. If you are found without your stall door tagged or your Camper not tagged, you will be charged double. No more than 2 equines 11.2H and under per stall or Horse mare & foal.
12. **OTHER:** All **Dogs** on the show grounds must be leashed/restrained at all times. For safety purposes, dogs should not be near the show ring or gate areas. Owners of aggressive or nuisance dogs (as determined by show management) will be asked to remove them from the show grounds. No entry fees will be refunded. **Non-showing Equines:** Any horse on the grounds but not entered in a class will be charged \$25 for each day on the grounds. Coggins & Rabies will be checked, a release must be signed and if using a stall, stall fee must be paid.
