Rules and Regulations

1. Before making entries read Standards of conduct for Fairs and General Rules and Regulations of the Schoharie County Sunshine Fair.
2. Pre-entries must be postmarked with payment by July 7th. Entries are payable and mailed to Cobleskill Agricultural Society, PO Box 249, Cobleskill, NY 12043. After July 7th, Gymkhana entries will be accepted on show day starting at 7:30 a.m. A late fee of \$10 if not pre-entered.
3. **Two people per horse will be admitted free of charge if entering the day of the show.**
4. All entries must be accompanied by proof of rabies inoculation and negative coggins test. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
5. **Exhibitors MUST wear appropriate apparel; long sleeve western style button up shirts must be worn with a collar, buttons or snaps and western pants. NO TANK TOPS. Protective Headgear or Western Hat is required. Per New York State Law No. VAT1265, all riders 17 years of age and under must wear a helmet meeting or exceeding ASTM F1163 (Safety Equipment Institute Certified) equestrian standard. The parent/guardian who signs the release form for an exhibitor 17 and under is personally responsible for seeing that those exhibitor(s) in their care, custody and control obey this law.**
6. **EXHIBITORS MUST HAVE ENTRY NUMBER ON UPON ENTERING THE RING! IN SENIOR, JACK BENNY AND OPEN CLASSES EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE TO WEAR A HAT IN THE CLASS. DISQUALIFICATION WILL RESULT IF HAT TOUCHES THE GROUND.**
7. The Fair Society reserves the right to refuse any entry of an exhibitor who has shown an objectionable attitude toward a Sunshine Fair show or previous unsportsmanlike behavior at other shows or its management.
8. This show will follow New York State Saddle Horse Association rules. See www.nyssha.org for the rules.
9. No horses or ponies may be entered more than once in any class but horses can be entered in more than one Section. Example: a horse can be entered in Junior barrel race and also entered in Senior barrel race. In pee wee, leadline, and walk/trot classes horses and ponies may be used NO more than twice in a class. Exhibitors can ride more than one horse in a class, but each horse/rider combination must have a separate entry and exhibitor number. If the same horse is ridden in different classes with different exhibitors they must have a different back numbers.
10. A standing martingale or tie-down is permitted. An English or western saddle must be used. The saddle must correspond to the bridle. Any standard or western bit, hackamore or noseband may be used. The method of holding the reins is optional.
11. Bats or crops are permissible but may not be used forward of the cinch.
12. Age will be determined as of January 1 of current year.
13. 4H Division is open to 4H exhibitors that have designated project animals with the Extension Office by June 1. Only 4H exhibitors to compete in these classes. All Department 11 rules, Youth Department, section 80-Horse, apply to these 4-H division classes. NO running starts through the gate allowed in the 4-H Division.
14. Leadline Division is open to Exhibitors 3-8 years of age. Horses or ponies but stallions NOT allowed. Halter and bridle is required. Lead must be attached to the halter. Must be led by someone 14 years or older. Spotter is required for 3 & 4 year olds. No cantering allowed. Leadline may compete only in the Leadline Division.
15. Walk/Trot Division is open to riders of all ages. No cantering allowed. May only compete in the Walk/Trot division.
16. Pee Wee Division is open to all exhibitors 5 to 10 years of age. No lead attached. Horses or ponies but stallions **NOT** allowed. Pee Wee's may only compete in the Pee Wee Division.

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Rules and Regulations (Continued)

17. Junior Gymkhana Show is open to all exhibitors 17 years and younger. Horses or ponies but stallions **NOT** allowed. May only compete in the Junior Division with the exception of the non pointed Gymkhana classes.
18. Senior Gymkhana Show is open to all exhibitors 18 years of age and over. May only compete in Senior classes with the exception of non pointed Gymkhana classes.
19. Jack Benny Division is open to riders 39 years and older. May only compete in the Jack Benny Division with the exception of the non pointed Gymkhana classes.
20. Open Gymkhana Division is open to any rider 5 years and older.
21. A limited number of stalls will be available at \$12 per day. All stall reservations must be received with payment by July 7, 2017. Stalls will be available on a first-come, first-served basis. Daily reservations are from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. unless otherwise specified at time of reservation. Only stalls rented for more than one day will be occupied after 8 p.m. When making reservations, please state the number of stalls needed and the days they will be used.
22. A \$2.00 timer fee per horse will be charged. 4-H classes only are exempt.
23. Classes are listed specifically for junior exhibitors with cash prizes totaling \$644 offered.

Per New York State Law No. VAT1265, all riders 17 years of age and under must wear a helmet meeting or exceeding ASTM F1163 (Safety Equipment Institute Certified) equestrian standard. The parent/guardian who signs the release form for an exhibitor 17 years of age and under is personally responsible for seeing that those exhibitor(s) in their care, custody, and control obey this law.

The undersigned promises to exhibit at the Schoharie County Sunshine Fair the horses named and does hereby certify that said hereinafter mentioned horses, so proposed to be exhibited, is hereby entered for exhibition in accordance with the Rules and Regulations contained in the Cobleskill Agricultural Society Premium Book and by which the undersigned hereby agrees to be governed in exhibiting the same. The exhibitor agrees to be solely responsible for any loss or injury to or damage done, occasioned by, or arising from any animal, equipment, exhibit, or person on exhibition, and to defend and indemnify the Cobleskill Fair and the management thereof against all claims and liability in regard thereto, and upon these conditions only will entries be accepted. In view of the indemnity agreement appearing herein, exhibitors may find it advisable for their own protection to carry liability insurance if not covered. Exhibitor agrees to abide by the rules of the Cobleskill Agricultural Society.
